








# CHILD CARE CORNER

We made a rain cloud in a jar for STEM! Then we drew different weather symbols on our desks with shaving cream.


















3K finished up our doctor's unit last week with some free play! Check out these cute little doctors and nurses! We also worked on recognizing and matching our upper- and lower-case letters.



































The 1st grade students each chose a state to research at home, complete the poster, and present their posters in class. We had fun learning and the students put so much effort into these posters!




