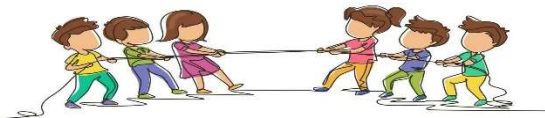




In 3K we start every day with interaction free play. We work on sharing and using our imagination to build things. We also work on fine motor skills.



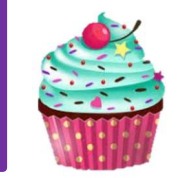
Tug of war fun in PE class. We had a discussion prior to starting about sportsmanship and cheering on everyone not just our friends. The students did a good job at following the rules!
