We also named our pumpkins, added some eyes, and color and got to write all about our pumpkins!



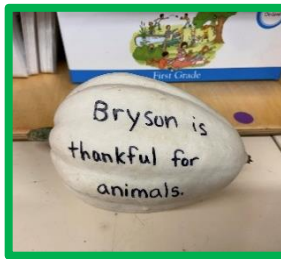

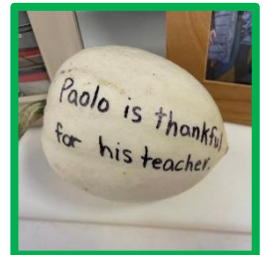
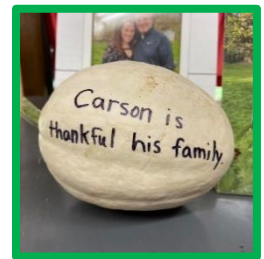
