- Supervise and engage children in educational activities, both indoors and outdoors
- Assist with daily routines, including mealtime, naptime, and bathroom breaks
- Maintain a clean and organized classroom environment
- Communicate positively

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent required; Associate's degree in Early Childhood Education preferred
- Previous experience working in a daycare or preschool setting required
- Knowledge of activity planning and implementation for young children
- Knowledge of general child growth and development and developmentally appropriate activities for children required
- Familiarity with behavior management techniques
- Ability to effectively communicate and collaborate with parents, staff, and children

- Patience, compassion, and a genuine love for working with young children
- A state-required criminal background check will be performed prior to working
- Infant/Child CPR & AED certified within 3 months of hire
- Complete the Safe Environment Training required by the Archdiocese of Milwaukee

Physical Requirements:

- Employees are required to frequently stand, walk, climb, stoop, kneel, crouch, and sit on the floor with the children
- The employee must be able to lift or move up to 30 pounds
- The employee must be able to perform CPR or first aid.
