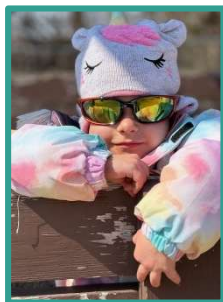

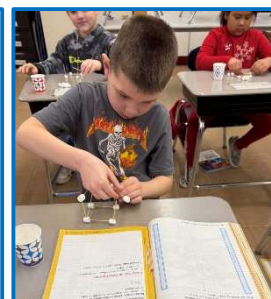

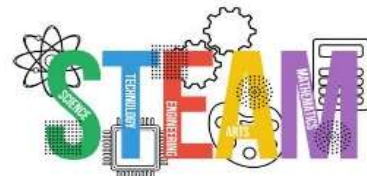

The students created a moon phase book with a partner, and we also began painting styrofoam balls to look like the Earth. We will be painting a moon and sun as well to demonstrate how the Earth rotates around the sun.

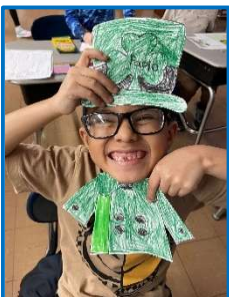
