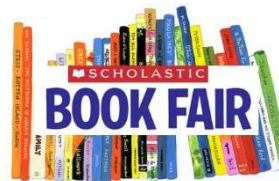

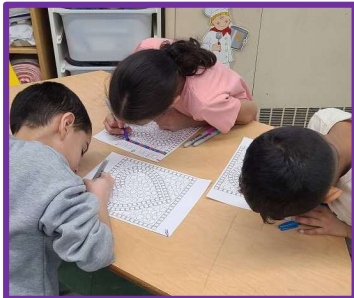

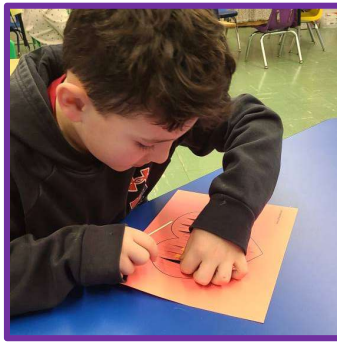




Busy Art classes this week!

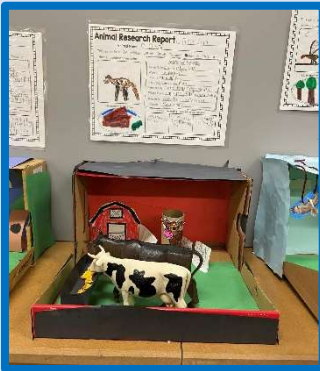




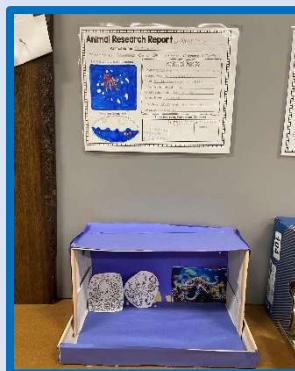
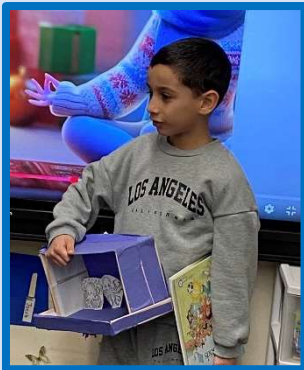
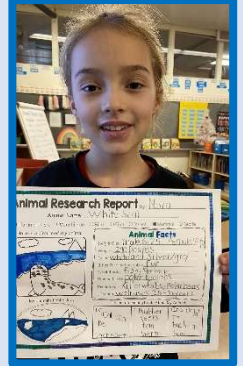
# CHILD CARE CORNER
