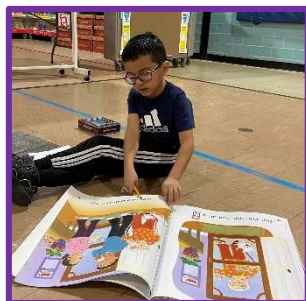
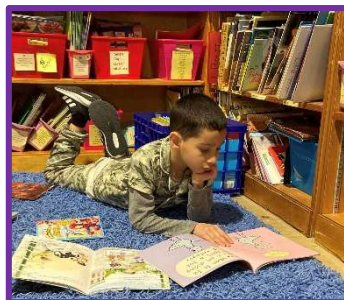
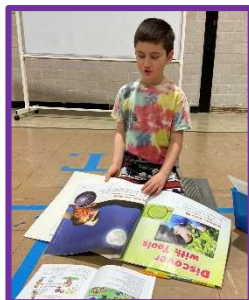
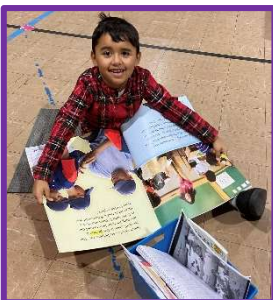
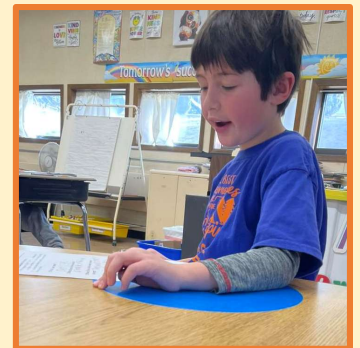
The 1st graders searched our school for symbols that celebrate our Catholic faith.
