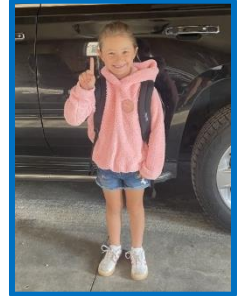
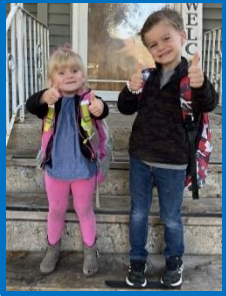
What do you do when it's so hot and it's a PE day? Water balloons of course! Students had a blast and no one complained about the heat 🥵



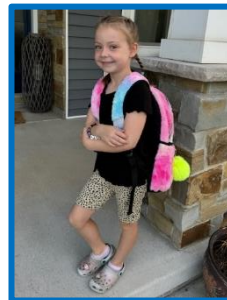
