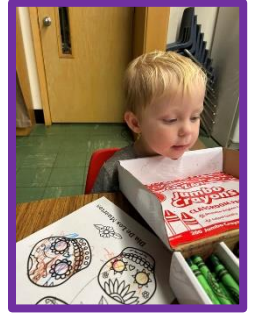
In 3K we are preparing for Thanksgiving. We are learning about Native American Indians and made teepees. We also made cards for Veterans Day!



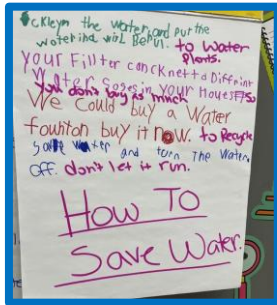

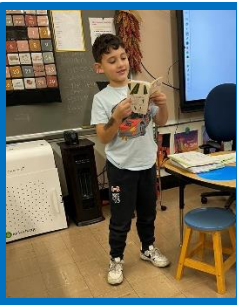
# CHILD CARE CORNER

The 1st graders not only prayed the Rosary in the month of October, but they created lapbooks that taught them about the Mysteries too.



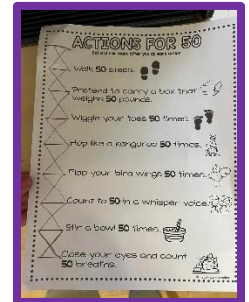
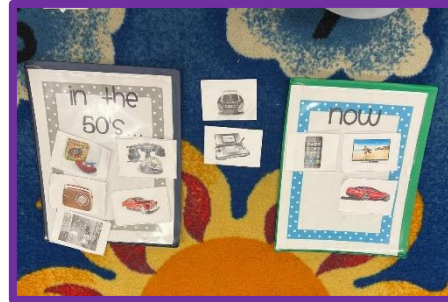
