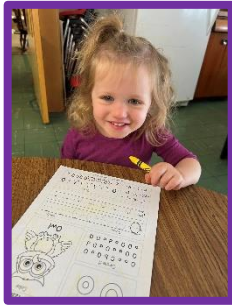


# CHILD CARE CORNER



We worked on more letters this week, did some motor skills activities and painted our clay monsters!

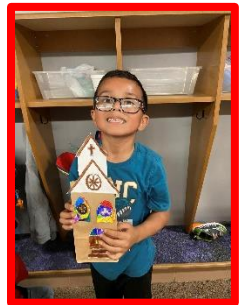

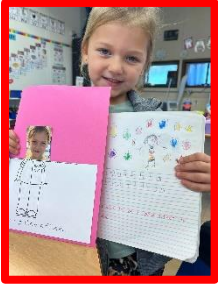
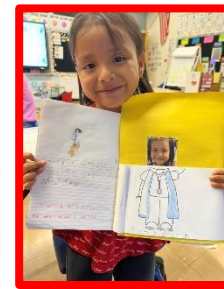


The 1st graders have been learning about being part of our church community and they really enjoyed creating their own churches. We even put battery-operated candles inside to make them glow.

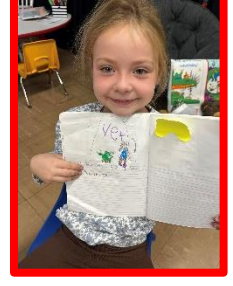




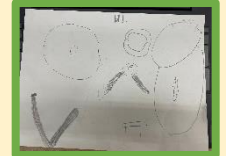
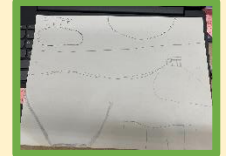
# hello KINDERGARTEN



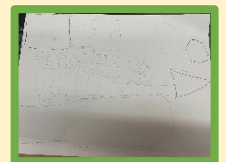
We are learning all about community helpers in Kindergarten this week! Our class is filled with students that want to be vets, detectives, fire fighters, doctors, and police officers.
