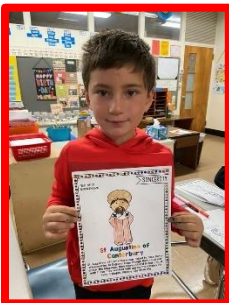
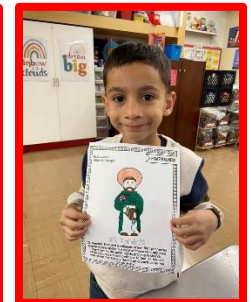
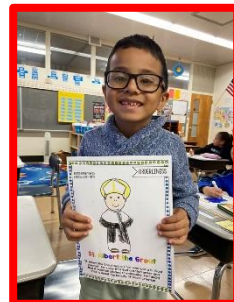
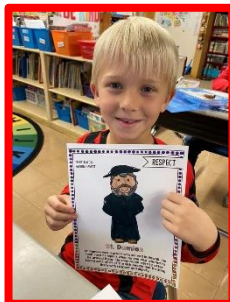
Thank you to the Religious Education students! They earned some service hours by pulling weeds and washing windows at the school. Thanks for helping to keep the school look good!



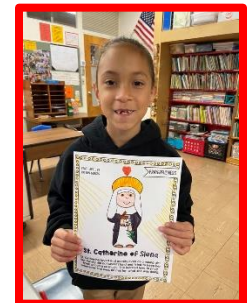
What did our ghosts eat?

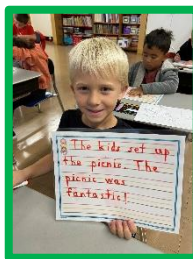

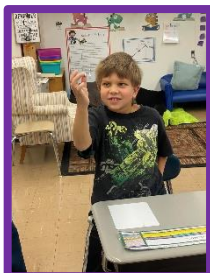
