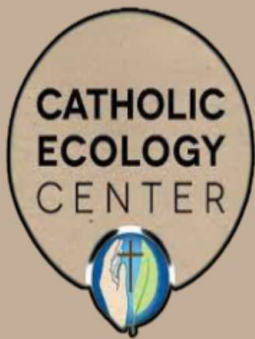

We've had lots of fun in Childcare! Group activities during Spring Break and a visit from Miss Cassy's bunny! We did some painting and learned about brushing our teeth.

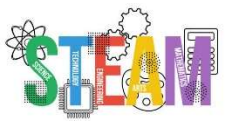


Kinder is learning all about vets and animals! For STEM this week, they had to make some sort of structure to keep their animal from getting out! They all had very creative and different ideas!

In 2nd grade, we worked on spiagraphs for our measurement unit in math. We measured the different-sized holes as well as the size of the spiagraphs that we created. In science, we built structures using marshmallows and toothpicks as part of our STEAM activities. We learned that just because you change the shape of something, it doesn't mean the material changes.





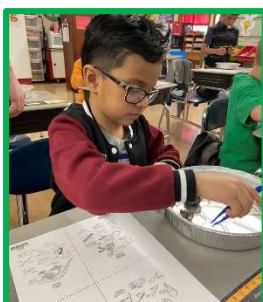
This week in Miss Katie's Art class, 3rd grade started their final recreation of Vincent Van Gogh paintings. This time they are using yarn to add dimension and texture to their creations. We will be displaying all 3 of their artwork forms (watercolor, color pencil and yarn) once completed.

2nd grade finished their city skyline of warm and cold colors. This was an introduction of use of colors to add depth to their artwork. They started a "color depth" project and will be displaying them next week!

5K & 1st grade also finished Moon/Sun sheet of warm and cold colors. Some also got to color a bird. Each student will be coloring a bird to represent themselves in "Our Flock" here at St. Mary's School!



In last week's STEAM lesson, the 1st graders dissected owl pellets! They found and sorted a variety of bones from small rodents that the owls ate.
