

Kinder is learning all about vets and animals! For STEM this week, they had to make some sort of structure to keep their animal from getting out! They all had very creative and different ideas!

They are enjoying playing with our vet set!































In 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, we worked on spirographs for our measurement unit in math. We measured the different-sized holes as well as the size of the spirographs that we created. In science, we built structures using marshmallows and toothpicks as part of our STEAM activities. 2nd grade finished their city skyline of warm and cold colors. This was an introduction of use of colors to add depth to their artwork. They started a "color depth" project and will be displaying them next week!

5K & 1st grade also finished Moon/Sun sheet of warm and cold colors. Some also got to color a bird. Each student will be coloring a bird to represent themselves in "Our Flock" here at St. Mary's School!
